



## Logic Training – Beginner

### Instructions:

*Gyokuseki, meaning "precious stones," puzzles are a popular gem in the puzzle world. Your task is to draw in black (solid) or white (see-through) circles into some of the cells under the following conditions. First, every row and column must have exactly one black (solid) circle, no more, no less. Numbers at the edges of the diagram indicate how many circles can be seen from that vantage point. You can see through white circles but cannot see through black (solid) circles. The number includes the black circle. In the example to the right, the 5 at the bottom indicates it can see 5 circles (4 see through and 1 solid). The 4 on the right indicates it can see 4 circles (3 see through and 1 solid). The 1 at the top can only see 1 circle, a solid black. Good luck!*
